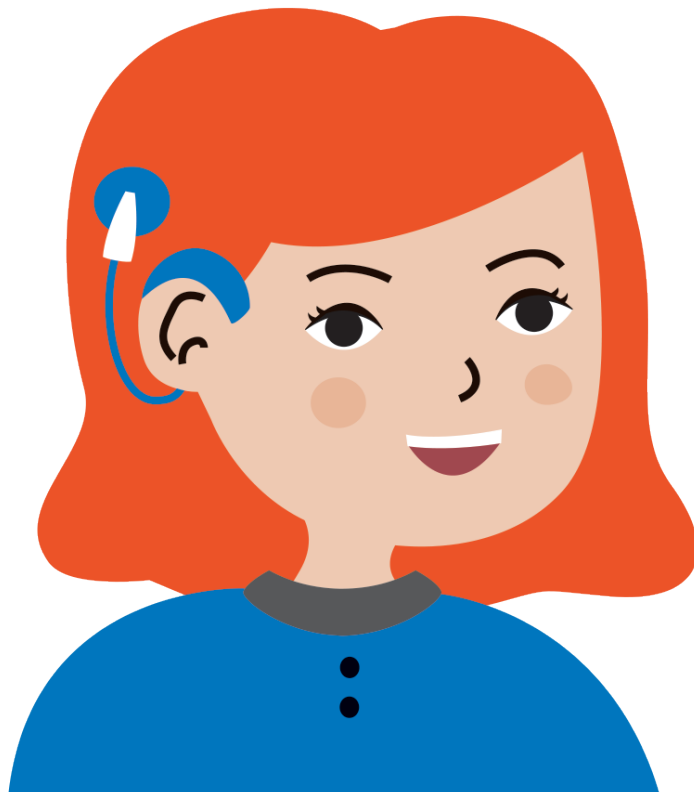
All the things I can do with my cochlear implant!

I can play music straight to my implant.

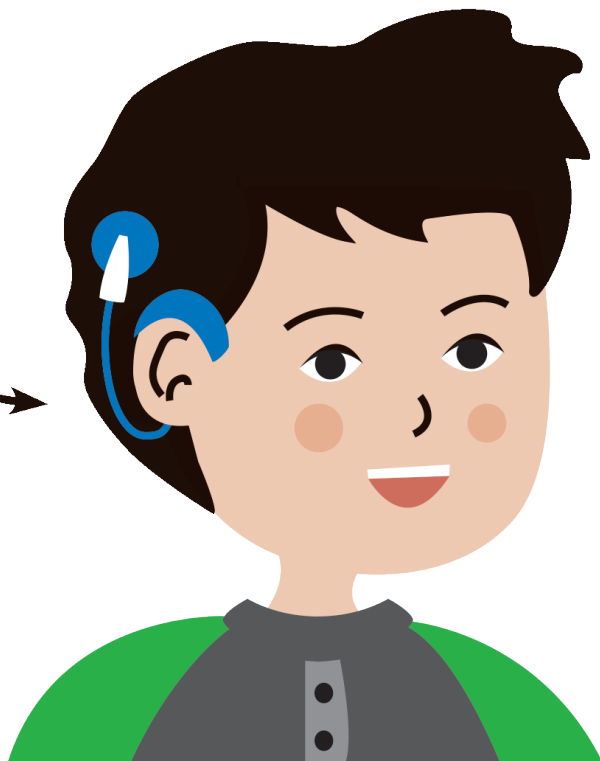
